As you know, the outing supports the SBA Widows' & Children's Fund, established in the aftermath of the September 11, 2001 terrorist attacks, when several active NYPD Sergeants lost their lives.

Today, the Fund provides COBRA health benefits to the widows and children of active SBA members, and to eligible families of Lifetime members who were not eligible for line-of-duty benefits.

The Fund also maintains a strong relationship with surviving families and supports commemorative events, including an annual holiday gathering for children, helping families remain supported and connected over time.

The Widows' & Children's Fund also engages in advocacy related to line-of-duty deaths through communication with elected officials, the media, and the parole board.

In addition, the Fund supports the Metro New York chapter of Concerns of Police Survivors (C.O.P.S.), which provides resources to families of fallen officers.

The annual golf outing is one of the Fund's primary fundraising efforts.

Your generous support helps sustain these programs and allows the Fund to continue meeting its commitments to the families it serves.
